### Verbal

Using words, statements and name calling to gain power and control over the target

- \*Name calling
- \*Relentless insults
- \*Teasing
- \*Intimidation
- \*Gender remarks
- \*Racist remarks
- \*Mocking someone's disability or limitation





Using physical actions to gain power and control over the target

- \*Hitting
- \*Kicking
- \*Tripping
- \*Pinching
- \*Pushing
- \*Shoving
- \*Slapping
- \*Punishing

### Cyber



- \*Online threats or inuendo
- \*Posting hurtful images
- \*Hurtful emails, texts, tweets
- \*Shameful videos





#### **Sexual**

Using unwanted words, actions or images about sex to target a person

- \*Sexual name calling
- \*Crude comments
- \*Vulgar gestures
- \*Uninvited touching
- \*Pornographic material
- \*Slut shaming
- \*Sexting

## **Racist Bullying**



- Racism, where the bullying focuses on race, ethnicity or culture
- \*Behaviour that is hostile
- \*Behaviour that is offensive

- \*the colour of your skin
- \*Your cultural or religious background
- \*Traditions or ethnicity
